

## **The U.S. Department of Transportation Center for Climate Change and Environmental Forecasting**

The U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) established the DOT Center for Climate Change and Environmental Forecasting in 1998 to coordinate the Department's efforts to understand and address transportation and climate change issues. It is a multi-modal, virtual Center led by eight DOT operating administrations and the Office of the Secretary. Through research, policy analysis, outreach and communications, and strategic planning, the Center works to build understanding and awareness of the connections between transportation and climate change, to develop and assess strategies to promote energy efficiency and reduce greenhouse gas emissions from transportation sources, and to provide transportation perspectives and technical expertise to national climate change policy discussions.
